

Proper Dismissal Procedure



Dear Families,

We love all our Trinity students, and we want to make sure each one stays healthy and strong. Our afternoon dismissal procedure is designed to help us meet that goal.

Please note that according to the Parent-Student Handbook, students are to leave the building through the back doorways to meet their rides in the gym parking lot or the parking area beside the church. All students are to wait for their rides in one of those locations and are not allowed to play in any of the play areas. The gym parking lot is the only area that is supervised after school.

Parents who wish to park on 5th Avenue or California Street must come into the building to get their children. No students should leave from the front doors of the school without an adult.

The grassy area in front of the building along California Street is not fenced as a safe play area. Activities such as chase games, climbing, and catch are fun on the playground, but are not safe in front the school. Students who are playing in this area after school will be asked to sit in the entrance way until their ride arrives.
