Principal's Corner

Here we are approaching the 4th quarter! For me, the school year has gone so quickly. It feels like it was just Christmas and now it's almost Easter.

When April approaches, it is easy to think the end is near and start to get in summer mode too soon. It is common for student effort to slack a little in the 4th quarter. It's common, but that doesn't mean it's ok.

Remember that feeling you and your children had at the start of the school year. Your child was well organized, came right home from school and completed unfinished work, was excited for the next projects, the backpack was clean and organized. Let's bring back that September feeling in April!

Here are some tips to finish the school year strong and make the 4th quarter the best it can be.

- Keep a consistent bedtime routine. This can be a challenge when it stays light longer, but a tired child turns into a cranky child.
- Provide a snack for your child. We have many hungry children looking for a snack. It's hard to learn when your tummy is rumbling.
- Some students need help and guidance with backpack organization. As a parent, it is helpful if you can go through your child's backpack at least once a week.
- Communication Please read the newsletter from your child's teacher and this newsletter every week. We don't want you to miss anything important.
- 5) Simplify Planning ahead helps to simplify your life. Try to avoid stops at the store each night on your way home. This is exhausting to both the children and the adults.
