As I shared with you last week, the school auction was a huge success. This week, we would like to celebrate some numbers!

**250** friends of Trinity attended the auction. The auction team was made up of **30** faithful volunteers.

Total volunteers for this event was between **75-100**. Thank you everyone for attending and volunteering.

We will be able to help so many families with nearly **\$25,000** in scholarship money. What a blessing this is! Time and again I have seen scholarship recipients later give to our scholarship account. What a great way to give back!

The raffles are an important part of our fundraising. Our students and families sold **2,860** raffle tickets. Through the vacation and gun raffles, we raised **\$64,750**. Thank you for participating!

The music department raised \$7,441. Mrs. Gargasz has already started to spend some of this with the purchase of a marimba and a box drum.

Our school and church families, as well as the Flathead Valley show their support of Trinity through sponsorships. This year we had **43** sponsors that brought in **\$32,500**.

The live auction brought in \$22,350 and the silent auction raised \$16,372.

The final net profit hasn't been finalized yet because of some expenses still coming in.

We feel very blessed by the generosity of our community and our school and church family.




