## **Principal's Corner**

This week your family received a large envelope filled with auction raffle tickets. We are asking each family to get involved by selling tickets to neighbors, coworkers and loved ones. You can sell not only to people who live locally, but also to friends who live across the country. Those who are out of town can purchase through our website and your student will still get credit for these raffle tickets sold. Our goal is for each student to sell 15 tickets. How many do you think your family can sell?

So why are we asking students to sell tickets? 1) With our auction funds, we are able to cover expenses that are not part of our budget. For example; the new bell and clock system was purchased with auction funds as were the Promethean interactive boards in the classrooms. A portion of our auction funds was also used for the roof and HVAC. So you can see we are able to do big things with our auction funds.

2) Selling tickets allows many people to be involved in our auction. Students are involved by selling and friends and loved ones are involved by purchasing. It is great when our circle of people who love Trinity just gets bigger and bigger.

3) Selling raffle tickets is a fairly easy way to raise a lot of money for your child's school. Last year in raffles alone we raised \$ 58,725.


