Jeremiah 29:11

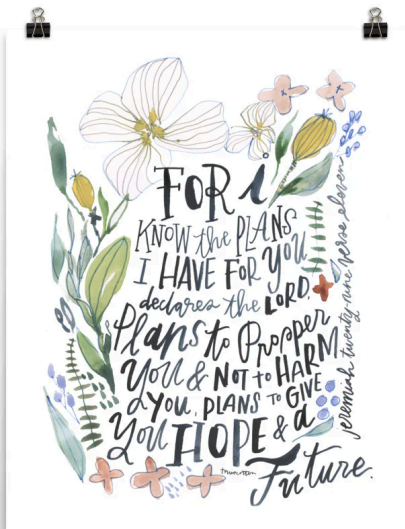
Numerous times I have used this verse when sharing life or career changes. It can be difficult to make changes, but decisions that are made after much prayerful consideration, come with peace.

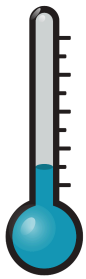
