#### Principal's Corner

As we get closer to this season of Thanksgiving, we may find ourselves reflecting more often on how to raise a thankful child.

Parents have the best intentions in raising a thankful child. Even young children can be taught to say please and thank you. Sometimes even when we have to give them a prompt. ("What do you say?") A two-year old might be encouraged to say thank you to Grandma for a gift. A four year old might be able to sign their name to a thank you card. Our goal is for a thankful heart that happens naturally without prodding.

One important way to teach gratitude is by modeling it. As parents, do you look at the bright side of things? Do you choose an attitude of gratitude even when things aren't going perfectly.

Being thankful to your children is another great way to show your gratitude. This means you have to give your children opportunities to do a job for which you can be thankful. Sometimes it's easier and quicker for you to tidy up the backpacks, put the laundry away or clear the table, but giving children responsibility also gives you an opportunity to praise.
