Principal's Corner

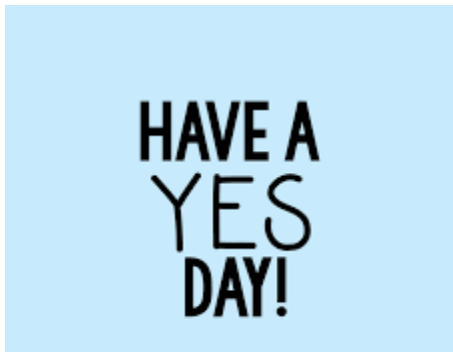
Teachers field all kinds of questions throughout the day. "May I go to the bathroom?" "Can this assignment be due on Monday?" "Can we have extra recess?" Some of these questions are important and some are frivolous. While it is easy to often say "no" to these many questions. Saying "Yes," (as long as it doesn't cause a problem) can foster a growth mindset and can be empowering for creativity.

As we consider the power of "yes" for our students, it is important to consider that our God embraced the power of "yes" for each of us. God could have easily said "no" to us because of our sinful nature. "No – you sinned and cannot enter My presence. No – our relationship is permanently severed. No – You have failed to meet My standard of perfection."

How hopeless this would have been! Yet, while God had every reason to say "no" to us, He offered a giant YES!– Yes, I will send my Son to take away your sins. Yes – You are my beloved child. Yes – I love you so much that I want you in eternity with Me."

Of course, there are times when "no" is the most loving response to a child for their own safety, for the classroom environment, or for their own growth and development. Yet, let's seek out those opportunities to say "yes" as often as it is appropriate. After all, we have the God of the "yes" as our model.
