

Principal's Corner

As parents our goal is to raise our children to be successful and productive adults. We want our children to work hard, to have grit and to persevere no matter what the circumstances.

This is a process that involves steps from toddler until adulthood. These small steps may seem insignificant when the child is young, but missed steps are impactful. Here are some examples of small steps:

- 1. Your child carries their own backpack.
- 2. Pre-kindergarten and kindergarten students should not be carried into class.
- Your child is responsible for packing their backpack including special things like show and tell or stuffies on special occasions. They are also responsible for unpacking it when they arrive to class.
- 4. Students can be responsible for putting a snack in their backpack.

Responsibility steps for older students could include:

- 1. Chores at home that they are not paid for. The reason for no pay is the idea we are a family and we all contribute to be helpful.
- 2. Students make their own lunch.
- 3. Students are responsible for turning in their own homework and communicating with their teacher about missing assignments.
- 4. Students are responsible for extra gear: band instruments, PE clothes, and sports uniforms.

Of course some of these steps require some supervision on the part of the parent. If your child is packing their own lunch, the parent should check that it isn't made up of all Halloween candy.

If your child is struggling with turning in work, you may need you to walk beside them. This doesn't mean you do it for them, it means you hold them accountable for doing it.

Children, just like adults, learn from mistakes and failures. This makes us stronger.
